Reasons (Justification)

The mentioned products do not contain any additives, which could be qualified as impure [najis] according to Islamic law, are not produced from any impurity [najasat] and do not contact any impurity during the production process. This has been evaluated by Muslim experts based on the presented detailed data, on the existing list of additives and the plant visit on the 6th of October 2011.

The mentioned product is based on vegetable, synthetical and mineral raw material, which is delivered to the production plant in Wöllersdorf (town in East Austria) within closed units. The storage is fulfilled in closed units.



Any mixture with non-halal products can be excluded. The transport of compounds through the production is monitored by a automated data acquisition system, so that it is always possible to identify the exact source of the used compounds and traceability is ensured. The production takes place in own facilities.

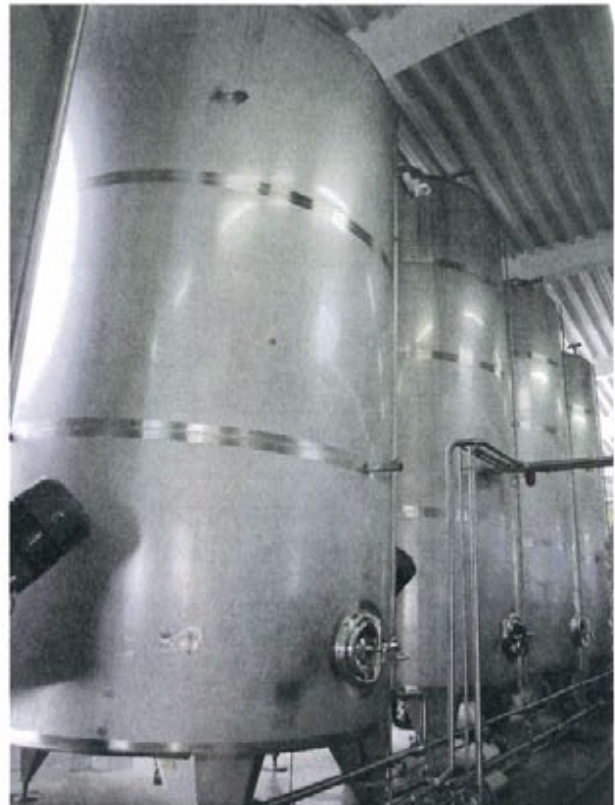
The ingredients used for the mentioned energy-drinks are:

All used agents are extracted from vegetable or mineral sources or are synthetically and are therefore permitted (halal). The flavors and coloring agents are also synthetically produces and do not contact ethanol in any production process.

The production process of the raw material for the energy-drinks itself includes mechanical and thermal mixing processes which are applied in batch-units.



Some stages of the production are used as well as for the halal production and the non-checked. Nevertheless any contact of impurity [najasa] to the halal-production utterly out of the question due to the extensive purifying processes with extensive pure water of all facilities between the different productions.

The cleaning of all equipments takes place in planned intervals by using detergents and water. All cleaning processes are finished with pure water.

Neither the raw material nor the products get in any contact with human skin during all processes based on the automation from delivery of raw material up to packaging. At the stages with manual work, where a theoretically contact would be possible all workers are obligated to wear gloves.

The packaging of the product (here filling in çan) takes place absolutely automatically in own facilities, where the cleaning processes before halal-production are applied as well.

Inside the manufacture exists a strictly ban of alcoholic drinks for all employee since. The company applies a quality management system according to GMP (Good Manufacturing practice).



Conclusion

The transparency of all production stages as well as the information of all used material inside the facilities do not let any doubt, that the mentioned product

has to be classified as "pure" [tahir] and permitted and are therefore "halal" for Muslims.
